WE ARE SENT TO:


- 1. Create spaces to experience an encounter with God.

GLOSSARY

- 1- <u>Healthy and just relationships</u>: Equal, inclusive, respectful, fostering dignity and growth.
- 2- <u>Peripheries</u>: Those who are outside the system and do not count. The excluded, voiceless, those who do not know God and those without meaning in life.
- 3- <u>Go beyond our own boundaries</u>: To go out of ourselves to share the Good News. To create networks to work at the levels of interprovincial, intercongregational, interfaith, intergenerational, intercultural, international...
- 4- <u>Companions in Mission</u>: Lay people and Religious journeying together in the charism of Jesus and Mary and in the mission of the Church.
- 5- <u>Formation</u>: initial and on-going formation in spiritual, professional and pedagogical studies, including religious and laity in view of Shared Mission.
- 6- <u>Flexible Structures</u>: adaptation of our lifestyle to respond better to current realities; open, adaptable, and available at all levels.
- 7- <u>Projects</u>: respond to immediate needs, which could be focused and short term.
- 8- <u>Common Home</u>: Cf. Encyclical Letter "*LAUDATO SI*" of the Holy Father Francis on Care for our Common Home, 2015.
